

Proper Use of Self-Storing End Extensions

Extending the leaf

#1 Reach under the top and pull the leaf out toward you.



#2 The leaf will drop down as it nears the end of its travel.



#3 Lift the leaf up as far as it will go.



#4 Reach underneath and firmly hold the closest cross rail.

- #5 As you slide the top toward the table by pushing with your right hand, keep pulling the closest rail with your left hand. This first rail must not be allowed to slide away from you with the top.



- #6 If the closest rail is allowed to move away from you as you push the top in, it may seem okay until the leaf suddenly drops with a crash during dinner.



- #7 The first and second rails must be spread as far apart as they will go in order to lock the leaf in position.

Retracting the leaf

#8 Pull the leaf toward you by holding the leaf in the finger cutout. Do not hold the rail. Keep pulling.



#9 Now push the leaf in by pushing on the first rail. The leaf will drop. Just keep pushing until the leaf goes under all the way.



#10 That's all there is to it. We recommend you practice several times.

Remember, the bars must be spread apart as far as they will go when the leaves are extended.
