

Robert Jupe built his version of the extension tables between 1830-1840 in England.

These antique tables have become very valuable.

We at Bausman introduce two new options for Jupe Extensions.

The Manual Jupe Extensions

The Manual Jupe Extension starts with a 48" diameter table. It starts out round and extends to 60" diameter. When the table is extended it is not a true round but more of a rose shape. This table top has 6 segments. It requires that each of these segments be pulled out in order to gain access to the extensions. The extensions then flip open into place and the 6 segments must be pushed back in to close the table. These Manual Jupe Extensions are suitable when a smaller pedestal is used.

The Swivel Jupe Extensions

The Swivel Jupe mechanism is more complex and expensive than the Manual Jupe. The table starts at 60" diameter (rose shape) and extends to 72" perfect round. The 4 segments automatically open when the table is swiveled. The 4 leaves then rise up and each one is folded out and then the top is swiveled again to tighten. The downside of this design is that the table needs considerable weight in order not to slide on a hardwood floor when being swiveled. With solid pedestal designs we can weight the pedestals by adding steel to the inside. Lighter designed pedestals will not allow this and therefore the Manual Jupe design will be more desirable. The classic pie top lends itself very well to either of these two extension options though as always, custom is available.
